



The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program is awarded from progeny sired by stallions nominated in the ABHA Stallion Incentive Program. All proceeds collected from the ABHA Stallion Incentive Program and Auction will go towards a bonus at the 2026 ABHA National Finals for eligible horses entered in the Futurity, Maturity and Open Divisional. The highest placed horse in each event listed will determine the winners of the bonus.

This will be the 5th consecutive year the ABHA Stallion Incentive has been running. The program is growing with excitement, prizemoney and involvement, you only need to look at the increase of prizemoney and participation each year!

2022 – \$23,434.75 33 Stallions
2023 - \$36,432.11 41 Stallions
2024 – \$44,835.42 39 Stallions
2025 – \$52,075.00 41 Stallions

The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program also requires an entry fee of \$55 from eligible progeny which is added to the total prizemoney.

Payouts will be split equally between the 3 events as follows: 40% stallion owner, 40% rider and 20% ABHA.

This year we are using an online system to nominate your stallion. All enrolments close Friday 3rd July 2026. Two options for/or on behalf of stallion owner:

OPTION 1

NOMINATE STALLION BY DONATING A SERVICE FEE TO THE STALLION AUCTION

- The auction will open Sunday 12th July 2026 7pm and close Sunday 26th July 2026 7pm EDST via STOCKLIVE. The donor reserves the right to bid on his/her own behalf.
- Minimum bids start at \$500. If minimum bid is not met the service will not be awarded and the stallion owner is responsible for paying the \$385 (inc GST) nomination fee for the stallion to remain in the Stallion Incentive Program.
- Bids will be accepted in \$50 increments and only accepted through STOCKLIVE.
- A Live Foal Guarantee is required with this contract and a breeding certificate issued to the mare owner on/after a 45-day positive heartbeat scan.
- All mare care, shipping, vet expenses, etc will be between winning bidder and stallion owner.
- Chute fees (if applicable) will be paid by the mare owner and are PLUS the winning bid (not included in the service fee).
- The stallion owner will be provided with the name, address and phone number of the winning bidder via email from ABHA.



OPTION 2

NOMINATE STALLION BY PAYING ENROLMENT FEE ONLY - \$385 (inc GST)

- Complete the online form, payment will also be taken at this time.
- Enrolments close 3rd July 2026.

Terms & Conditions

1. No refunds for any reason. Death of stallion, inability to collect, sold stallions must be handled between stallion owner and winning bidder. The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program will be held harmless in these matters.
2. The ABHA govern the Futurity, Maturity, Open and Stallion incentive program and reserves the right to refuse entry to any horse or individual. All decisions are final.
3. All horses must be registered to be eligible for The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program. (Quarter Horses, Stock Horses, Thoroughbreds and Paint Horses).
4. All progenies must be sired by a current stallion paid into The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program.
5. Progeny can be by stallions who are deceased or gelded, however the stallion must be paid in for progeny to be eligible.
6. A person or persons could pay in a stallion, if the stallions registered owner chooses not to. The ABHA must receive written permission from the registered owner of the stallion and confirmation on which person to pay if said stallion wins prizemoney.
7. Owners do not have to ride horses and riders may ride more than one horse; payouts will go to the nominated rider unless other arrangements have been advised in writing to the ABHA prior to the event.
8. A copy of all progeny registration papers must be submitted when entering.
9. At no point during the event can a member come to the ABHA to submit registration paperwork; your horse will not be eligible if not approved upon entering.
10. The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program provides a bonus exclusively for eligible progeny sired by enrolled stallions in The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program.
11. The percentages of money will be split evenly between the 3 events: 40% stallion owner, 40% rider and 20% ABHA.
12. Futurity and Maturity horses are eligible to run for the bonus if entered in the open divisional and do not pay extra entry fees.
13. Number of places paid will be pending the amount of money raised by the stallion auction and number of enrolled stallions.
14. All eligible progenies are to pay \$55 upon entry to compete in The ABHA Stallion Incentive Program.
